The lion cub looks up at a mountain far bigger than he is, and climbs anyway. What is something you dream about that feels too big for you right now? What is one small step toward it?

The Secret Flower

Doodlebug finds something beautiful that was hidden the whole time, just waiting to be noticed. What is something ordinary around you that might be more wonderful than you've noticed?

The Garden

Every creature in the garden was made on purpose, to be exactly who it is, and nothing else. If someone asked you what you were made to be, what would you tell them?
